## Tool: CLRLoad

Names	CLRLoad
Category	<a href="#">Malware</a>
Type	<a href="#">Loader</a>
Description	( <a href="#">ESET</a> ) CLRLoad is a generic Windows PE that we have seen in both 32-and 64-bit versions. It is a loader written in C++ that loads the next stage ( <a href="#">PNGLoad</a> ), which must be a Common Language Runtime (CLR) assembly DLL file. That code is loaded from a file located on disk in a legitimate directory, presumably to mislead victims or incident responders into thinking it is legitimate software.
