

Threat Actor Claims Breach of Siam Cement Group Database

A recent post on a Telegram channel has alleged a data breach of the Siam Cement Group (SCG), a leading ASEAN conglomerate known for its sustainable business practices. The post, attributed to the threat actor group SILKFIN AGENCY, claims responsibility for the breach, stating that the database was compromised on August 20, 2024.

According to the message, the stolen data includes over 16,000 B2B lines and spans a decade's worth of records from 2014 to 2024. The compromised information reportedly contains sensitive details such as company IDs, administrative information, contact details, installation locations, building specifications, and various approval signatures.

SCG, recognized globally for its leadership in sustainability and innovation, is committed to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. The implications of this breach on the company's ongoing initiatives and reputation remain to be seen.
