

GlobeImposter decryptor

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Please note that these free tools are provided as-is and without warranty of any kind. The tools may only work with specific ransomware versions, and may not work with versions that were released after a tool was created. Technical support for the tools is available only to customers using a paid Emsisoft product.



GlobeImposter is a Globe copycat that imitates the ransom notes and file extension found in the Globe ransomware kit. Encrypted files have the extension *.crypt and the base name of the file is unchanged. The ransom note is named "HOW_OPEN_FILES.hta" and can be found in all folders that contain encrypted files.

To start the decryption process you will need a file pair consisting of an encrypted file and the non-encrypted version of the same file. Select both and drag and drop them onto the decrypter binary to start the process.
